

2022 Tonganoxie Festival of the Arts Paint Outs and Paint My Place Competitions Kane Family Farm

General Rules

Registration/Check-in will happen each morning. At this time you will get your blank canvases/papers stamped and you will sign up for the Paint My Place in which you choose to participate. If you have previously checked in and had your canvases/papers stamped and have signed up for your Paint My Place choices, you are free to go directly to the Painting location. However, please be mindful of the starting and stopping times for each event.

The paintings are to be turned in directly after each event to the Hay Barn Milk Room. Artists are responsible for labeling each painting with a price and contact information. All paintings should be properly framed and ready to hang. If the painting is on a pre-stretched canvas with a width of at least one inch and the sides are painted, the artist can choose to display it as is without a frame. Any painting sold in the gallery is subject to a 20% commission to support the Tonganoxie Arts Council.

Paint My Place: Competitors will get to choose one of the two locations to paint for a \$300.00 purchase prize. Location selection for artists is on a first come – first serve basis. Winners for each Paint My Place will be chosen by the sponsor immediately after the competition ends and will be announced at the Awards Ceremony on Sunday, May 15th.

Paint Outs: The prize amount for a Paint Out is \$300.00. Anyone participating in this event will submit their painting at the end of each Paint-out. All artists are on the honor system to respect the time limit.

Best-in-Show – The Best in show prize is \$400.00. Any painting created during any of the competitions and not chosen as a Paint my Place Winner by the sponsor or not otherwise sold to the public before 12 pm on Sunday, May 15th will be eligible to win the best in show. Judge to be determined. The Best in Show winner will become next year's commemorative print. Artists submitting a painting for Best in Show agree to allow Tonganoxie Arts Council the right to photograph, produce prints and sell prints of the painting. The artist will cooperate with the Arts Council to arrange to sign and number the prints.

Maps will be available for each painting location at the registration desk.

All artists will be issued a name tag at sign-in. Artists are required to have their name tag displayed when painting at all locations. It is requested that you be courteous and respect private property rights of landowners and that you respect the nature of your surroundings and environments. The dumping/disposal of solvents or any other corrosive material while on location will not be allowed. You are reminded to abide by all public laws.

Please note that the Arts Council will collect and remit the sales tax on any artwork that you sell from the gallery. So, please price your work pre-tax. If you win a prize you will be required to sign a W-9 for our bookkeeping purposes.

All paintings displayed in the gallery that are not purchased shall be picked up no later than 3pm Sunday, May 15th.
